

GOVO RECYCLES ELECTRONICS THROUGH



e-cycleNYC is a free and convenient electronic waste recycling service provided by the NYC Department of Sanitation and Electronic Recyclers International. As of January, 2015, it is illegal for New Yorkers to discard electronics in the trash, with a \$100 fine per offense. This program was established to keep harmful materials from going to landfills.

We have established two (2) sites on our property where GOVO Residents can bring e-cyclables

Our Porters have been scheduled to pick up any electronic devices (see list, below) for e-cycling on WEDNESDAYS. Please leave any e-cyclables you may wish to discard on your stoop with a note indicating "e-cycle" by 8 AM each Wednesday.

NOT Accepted

- No appliances.** Any household appliances which are mostly metal or mostly plastic can be recycled as part of your building's regular recycling program.
- No loose batteries.** Regular alkaline batteries can be discarded as regular trash. Consumer take-back programs exist for rechargeable batteries.
- No light bulbs or ballasts.** These can be carefully discarded in the trash. Consumer take-back programs exist for fluorescent bulbs and CFLs.
